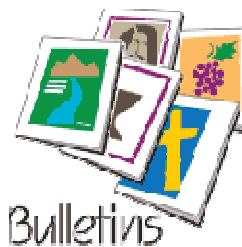

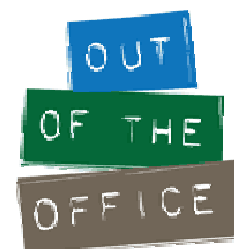
## WORSHIP BULLETIN
